










About: Youth Theatre Application Form



A Youth Theatre Application Form is a form that a youth theatre can send to interested young people, youth groups and centres and those who wish to enable a disadvantaged young person to join a youth theatre.

Why use.... A Youth Theatre Application Form?




This form allows the youth theatre to:

-  Gather names and contacts throughout the year;
-  Collate a database of young people that would be interested in hearing about your youth theatre events prior to joining;
-  Gather names and contacts for recruitment drives;
-  Gather information that might influence the artistic programme e.g. age range, theatrical interests, theatrical experience;
-  Encourage specific young people to come along to any open days, recruitment events, auditions etc.
-  Identify any trends that may be happening in the age range in their area;
-  Have an idea of demand.

The young person can:

-  Have the opportunity to express interest in joining the youth theatre at any time during the year;
-  Get more information about the youth theatre prior to joining.

Using and storing the information on a Youth Theatre Application Form

-  A youth theatre form is used to start a dialogue with those interested in your youth theatre.
-  It should be used to plan ahead in relation to demand, recruitment and possible artistic programme.
-  As with all forms containing personal details youth theatre application forms should be stored appropriately.
