



What can I apply for?

You can apply to bring in a professional/skilled practitioner in a particular theatre skill to work with your youth theatre over 4 sessions.

A session is a two-hour workshop. These sessions can be scheduled over a number of weeks or over a weekend.

It is open to the youth theatre to decide which theatre skill they need support in. Theatre skills might include:

- voice
- movement
- mime
- stage combat
- text work
- character development
- commedia della arte

The youth theatre should choose the skilled practitioner to deliver the sessions but NAYD is happy to advise on this.

How do I apply?

Fill out the application form outlining specifically why you have identified the particular skill and the benefits you anticipate for your group.

Please also include a CV for the proposed artist. We will also require that upon completion of the workshops that an evaluation report will be submitted to NAYD together with any images or footage of the workshops. We would particularly welcome comments from the young people involved.

How much will NAYD contribute?

NAYD will cover the cost of the facilitator only to a maximum of €400. The scheme will not cover travel or other costs.

Payment will be made upon receipt of an invoice at the end of each individual session or upon completion of all. This should be submitted with the evaluation report to ensure payment.

NAYD will offer the Theatre Skills Training to two youth theatres in 2011. Applications must be submitted by the **4 March 2011** for delivery from **April to December 2011**.
